AVSSP Affiliation Fee	£800	Membership to the partnership allows for chn attending all Amber Valley sports festivals and competitions. They also provide CPD sessions throughout the year.	All chn will have equal access to local competition. Chn will develop a sense of team and personal pride. Staff will have CPD tailored to school's needs. We enter and compete in more sport competitions throughout the year.		
AVSP (Amber Valley Sports Partnership) Specialist Sports Coach Cheryl Naylor	£5700	Sports coach to come into school every Wednesday and deliver 2 infant classes and 2 junior class PE lessons. A weekly lunch time club for the whole school. Supports PE coordinator with the Sports Ambassadors and mini leaders to develop lunch time active play.	Specialist planning and assessment through a range of sport. School staff has improved confidence towards PE and sport through specialist mentoring. Children are encouraged to take leadership or volunteer roles that support sport and physical activity within the school.

Sports Equipment for lunchtimes	£610.00	Replace and restock equipment. Lack of sports equipment hampers diversity of activities.	Development of PE lessons and enriched lunch time activities for children. Sports Ambassadors able to provide a greater range of activities. Helps to improve physical activity for all children and keeps them engaged during the dinner hour.
Outdoor Sound System	£80.00	Provide alternative physical activity for children though dance.	Children are able to engage in dance throughout the week. Zone set up for dance, mini leaders support the sports ambassadors. This caters for children who wish to do something different from the sporting activities.
Playground Markings	Netball Court - £414.00 Single Lane Track - £219.00	Current playground markings are worn out and fading. Chn rarely use current markings correctly.	Side by side pitches (netball and football etc) would allow teachers to split classes into smaller teams while running parallel games. Also enables the court to be split in 3 different zones, this will enable PE lessons and the lunchtime activities to be run better and offer more diversity. Single lane track will be



			used for a daily 1Km run challenge for classes to complete. Over time, running stamina and strength will improve.
Play Leader	£2,750	7.5hr per week – help to create a more active and vibrant lunchtime.	Working hand-in-hand with the sports ambassadors, leading the lunchtime play and organising games/activities. To support and develop our school teams ready for competitions.
Staff release for training	£750	PE coordinator release time for PE admin, CPD and meetings.	PE coordinator to meet with AVSSP regularly to gain PE updates etc. To introduce new sports/games into the school. An increased knowledge of good practice in the deliverance of PE. To ensure that all of the PE data/admin jobs are up to date.
New Trim Trail	£6000-£8000 (possible grant for some of funds from PTFA)	New equipment to be ordered as it needs replacing due to wood starting to rot through age and wear/tear.	Children will develop their gross motor skills and develop improved core stability as the trim trail has areas that require core body strength in order to pull the body upwards. This will further develop their handwriting as their posture will be more secure. More PE lessons/games
