The Schools Sports Premium is additional funding to help schools increase participation and achievement in school sports. It is also available to help children achieve healthy lifestyles. The premium is calculated based on the number of children on the school's census.

This statement details how we are spending this funding this year to build on our achievements from last year. July '19 – Silver Sports Game Mark received –Award for schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community.

Key Indicators: (K1-5)

Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer. There are 5 key indicators that schools should expect to see improvement across:

- 1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school.
- **2.** The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement.
- 3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
- **4.** Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
- **<u>5.</u>** Increased participation in competitive sport.
